Personal data that we process

Rotar International processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide these to us yourself.

Below you will find an overview of the personal data that we process:

- IP address
- Location data
- Information about your activities on our website
- Internet browser and device type

Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors under the age of 16 unless they have the permission of their parents or guardian. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We, therefore, advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children to prevent data about children collected without parental consent. If you are convinced that we have collected personal information about a minor without that permission, please contact us via info@rotar.com, and we will remove this information.

For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

Rotar International processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Rotar International analyzes your behaviour on the website to improve the website and to adjust the range of products and services to your preferences.

Automated decision making

Rotar International does not take decisions based on automated processing about matters that may have (significant) consequences for persons. These decisions are made by computer programs or systems, without a human being (such as a Rotar International employee) among them.

How long we store personal data

Rotar International does not store your personal data for longer than strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Rotar International only provides to third parties and only if this is necessary for the implementation of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Rotar International uses only technical and functional cookies. We also use analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferences. We can also use this to optimize our website. You can opt-out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. Additionally, you can also delete all information that was previously saved via the settings of your browser.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. Also, you have the right to withdraw your consent for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Rotar International, and you have the right to data transferability. Meaning that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@rotar.com.

To ensure that you have requested inspection, we ask that you send a copy of your proof of identity with the request. Take care that in this copy your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Social Security Number are made unreadable to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as quickly as possible but within four weeks.
